Lahaina Parking

There are an abundance of pay lots, ranging in cost from a mere 50 cents to \$10. Some are pay-by-hour, some are all-day parking. Most of these lots now have electronic machines for payments. The machines accept credit cards so that you do not spend time stuffing bills into slots or searching under the couch cushions for extra change. The ones below are the main ones but there are a number of smaller lots as well.

Instructions for parking machines:

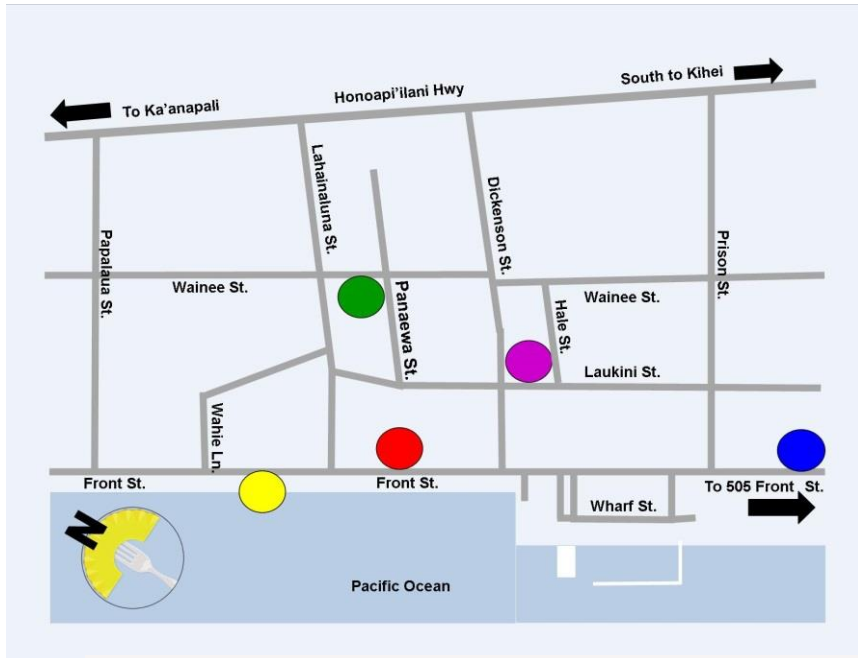
1. Park and remember your stall number
2. Input your stall number into the machine
3. Select the time duration you wish to pay for
4. Swipe your credit card or pay cash, bills only. Coins are rarely used.
5. Place the ticket back on your dashboard

Free Parking:

700 block Luakini Lane has a free parking lot and a few on the street. 600 Luakini Lane has a few along the street or, right off Prison and Front street. See #3 on map above. There are a number of free parking spots right on the streets in Lahaina but hard to find. Usually, it's a maximum of 3 hrs and it is checked. Do not park in any loading zones.



Where we start and finish on the tour:

-  Fleetwood's on Front: 1st stop
-  Lahaina Fish Co.
-  Betty's Beach Café
-  Kobe Maui
-  Ululani's Shave Ice: Last stop

Note: If you find a parking spot on the streets, you are checked every 3 hrs.

There are also a number of small parking lots on Lahainaluna Street, very close to Sargeant's Art Gallery, just past Wainee street heading towards the ocean on your right.

TIPS: If shopping at Hilo Hatties in Lahaina or Whaler's Village in Kaanapali or returning to dine at Lahaina Fish Co., bring your ticket with you to get it validated. You will have to show proof of items purchased, with receipt and minimum purchase of \$7-20 dollars varying by the store, at both Hilo Hatties and Whaler's Village.

For Lahaina Fish Co, park at the Lahaina Center Parking lot or #9 in the parking map on the first page.
