



## HTT's RAINY DAY ACTIVITIES Oahu

### **Waikiki Aquarium**

Seeing tropical fish and plants is a great activity for everyone of all ages. Admission is \$9 for adult and \$2 for kids ages 5 to 12. Each paid tour includes a free audio tour wand. [Waikiki Aquarium](#) is open daily from 9am to 4:30pm. The aquarium is located at 2777 Kalakaua Avenue, on the shoreline in Waikiki's Kapi'olani Park in Honolulu.

### **Learn Hawaiian Culture – Ukulele Lessons, Lei Making, Hula**

Many resorts offer free or low cost cultural lessons like hula, lei making and ukulele lessons. Check with your resort for their schedule.
